

In the event of a Collision

A quick-reference guide from CAA Magazine — Craig Moy Follow these tips to help make the post-crash process a little less stressful:

AT THE SCENE (9 things to do)

- 1 Stop your vehicle
- 2 Call 911: anyone injured or if damage to appears to be more than \$2,000. You should also call emergency services, especially *if you suspect the other driver is impaired*.
- 3 Record the collision details, including your speed, the location and road conditions.
- **Take photos** and **video** of the scene if it's safe to do so.
- Move your vehicle to the roadside when safely possible,
- 6 Turn on your hazard lights.
- **7** Exchange driver information:
 - drivers' licence details
 - phone numbers
 - insurance information.
- **8** Get the contact details of any witnesses if possible
- Answer police questions honestly, <u>but don't admit fault</u>.
 Your insurance company will determine that.
